



Green Procurement Policy

GJK Facility Services as part of our environmental strategy are committed to responsible purchasing and will try wherever possible to purchase products and services that are ethically produced and which minimise environmental impact.

The objectives of green purchasing policy are:

- To encourage the purchase of energy/resource efficient equipment.
- To encourage the purchase of chemicals which are environmentally friendly and sustainable.
- To increase awareness of environmental issues associated with procurement through training.
- Ideally all new products should be made from renewable, sustainable and natural resources.

Additionally the below considerations must be taken into account:

- What is the product's recycled content?
- What is the product's embodied energy, water, waste and greenhouse gas emissions?
- How much packaging is used?
- Are there any toxic chemicals (VOC's, heavy metals, carcinogens) or ozone depleting substances being emitted?
- What are labour conditions like?
- Are equivalent products available locally?
- How far does the product have to be transported?
- Is the quality and durability of the product appropriate?
- Can the product easily be repaired and/or upgraded?
- Is the product biodegradable?
- Are there any environmental toxicity concerns for disposal?
- Can the product be recycled or reused?

We will work in partnership with our Customers, Field Operators, Staff and Management to ensure that this Policy is achieved.
